This year, we proudly celebrated 30 years of providing dental care to local children. Last year, we served over 4,700 children through our clinic and in-school programs. We are pleased to announce the completion of the second phase of our building project, which has expanded our facilities to include second-floor space for children's therapy, run by our partner, Cheshire Fitness Zone. Over 6,500 visits were provided to local children needing occupational, speech and physical therapy services.



Thanks to generous donations to the Ruth Chadwick Care Closet, we provided emergency assistance to 10 families in need. Additionally, we continue to offer a support group for grandparents and other relatives who are raising children, providing them with the resources and community they need.

Pediatric Dental Center

CELEBRATING 30 YEARS OF PEDIATRIC DENTAL CARE

Brooker Memorial recently celebrated 30 years of providing high-quality dental care to children, regardless of the family's ability to pay. Dr. Isadore Temkin, a well-known Torrington dentist, saw a growing trend of families unable to afford oral health care for their children and approached our Board with the idea of creating a pediatric dental center. A generous gift from the Temkin family allowed Brooker Memorial to purchase medical equipment and instruments, an x-ray unit, and renovate space for the clinic. The dental center was dedicated in April 1994 in honor of Dr. Abraham Temkin, a respected and beloved local dentist, and brother to Dr. Isadore Temkin.

The clinic continues to grow, providing more than 9,100 visits last year to 4,726 patients in our Torrington dental center and at ten public schools. We are grateful for the generosity, knowledge, and interest shared by the Temkins in 1994 and for their dedication to our mission today.

IN-SCHOOL DENTAL CARE

In addition to providing care in our Torrington center, our dental staff provide oral health education and hygiene visits to students throughout the Torrington and Region One school districts. Generous funding from Foundation for Community Health, and Delta Dental, allowed Brooker to provide 2,978 students with oral health education and 688 students with preventative dental services in convenient school-based settings. Our hygienist provides educational materials, hands out goodie bags, and educates students on the importance of brushing, flossing, and healthy snacks. Services offered include dental cleanings, fluoride treatments, a caries risk assessment to determine if cavities are present, and if needed, sealants. This has become critical to families that cannot bring children to daytime appointments at Brooker due to transportation or scheduling barriers and allows children to spend more time in the classroom rather than leaving school for dental appointments.

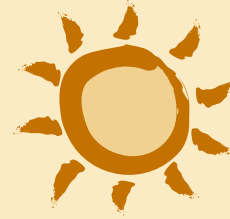




After 17 dedicated years, we bid a heartfelt farewell to our Dental Director, Dr. Karanki, who has relocated with her family out of state. Dr. Karanki's tenure at Brooker Memorial has been marked by her unwavering commitment to delivering compassionate and skilled dental care, always prioritizing the comfort of our young patients. Beyond her role at Brooker, Dr. Karanki made significant contributions to the broader community by volunteering at numerous Mission of Mercy events in Connecticut and Guatemala, and serving as the past co-chair of the Litchfield County Oral Health Collaborative, working tirelessly to enhance access to dental care for all. Dr. Karanki's leadership, expertise, and dedication will be deeply missed. Her smile and compassionate care have left a lasting impact on our community, and we wish her all the best in her future endeavors.

PROMOTING ORAL HEALTH

Brooker staff are dedicated to educating local families about the importance of fostering good dental habits from an early age and ensuring regular dental visits. During National Children's Dental Health Month in February, staff educate our community in fun and creative ways. A dental hygienist spends a morning at KidsPlay Children's Museum reading stories and offering free dental screenings. We also invite every youngster in our Child Care Center to visit the dental clinic, take a ride in the dental chair, and let the hygienist count their teeth. Staff visit local pre-schools to read stories, do a special art project, talk about the importance of visiting the dentist and what happens at a visit, and illustrate how to brush teeth properly. Our goal is to help children maintain healthy smiles for a lifetime by installing essential practices early on.

ADVOCATING FOR EXPANDED ACCESS

As designated by the State of CT Department of Social Services as a safety net pediatric dental clinic, Brooker is committed to equitable access to oral health services for all. 85% of our patient population is either receiving Husky insurance, or uninsured, making us the largest provider of dental care to low-income children throughout the region. As costs for dentists, dental clinicians, program supplies, insurance, and utilities have increased, the gap between reimbursement and expenses has widened. Despite increasing costs, Husky rates have been flat since 2007. We have been advocating state officials to increase the pediatric dental rate for community safety net providers so we can continue to reach more at-risk children in need of these critical services.

Child Care & Early Learning Center

AUTHOR & FRIEND VISIT CHILD CARE

In December our Child Care Center had a visit from author Rick Arruzza and his pal Dexter. Connecticut author Rick has written a series of books for young readers about his real-life rescue dogs Sparky and Dexter. Rick and Dexter visit schools and child care centers throughout Connecticut and beyond to promote literacy and pet adoption. They perform book readings, and share stories and pictures about the stars of the books. Rick donates a portion of each book sale to Greenwich, CT animal rescue Adopt-A-Dog and several other animal rescue agencies. Our kids loved the interactive story reading, and especially loved the opportunity to pet and scratch Dexter! He was such a good boy!

INTERGENERATIONAL FUN

The preschool students continue to be welcomed annually to Keystone Place at Newbury Brook for a fun Halloween celebration. The children have the opportunity to ride a bus and arrive dressed in their Halloween costumes. The residents and staff of Keystone dress up and decorate their hall for the children to trick-or-treat, do crafts, and sing songs. We truly enjoy this annual intergenerational activity!

NURSERY ANNIVERSARY

In the fall of 2014 we piloted a Nursery School Program in the child care center, and 10 years later it is still going strong! The program was developed for families who do not need a full day of care for their child, but want them to have a structured early learning experience to prepare them for school. The Nursery School program runs 3-4 mornings per week from September – June. Children work on early literacy, math, and science through developmentally appropriate activities both indoors and out. Nursery School provides children opportunities to learn and practice social skills, follow instructions, and begin the foundation for learning that will occur in elementary school. The program consistently receives excellent feedback from families, and many of our subsequent enrollment has been siblings of students who previously completed the program.





NATIONAL CELEBRATION OF CHILDREN

National Association for the Education of Young Children first established the Week of the Young Child in 1971, recognizing that the early childhood years (birth - age 8) lay the foundation for children’s success in school and later life. Each year in April our child care center participates in this national event to bring attention to the importance of children’s earliest years in shaping their learning and development. Week of the Young Child features designated themes for each day of the week. Music Monday was celebrated with a karaoke dance party. Tasty Tuesday brought us a visit from the ice cream truck! On Work Together Wednesday the children participated in a bubblemania group project, and created sidewalk art on Artsy Thursday. Finally, Family Friday was celebrated with a Family Memory table. Brooker is proud to be part of a larger community that works to support children in their new development.

PARTNERS FOR PROGRAM ENHANCEMENT

This year our Early Learning and Child Care Center partnered with the Early Childhood Consultation Partnership (ECCP), to participate in their Core Classroom service. The ECCP is a strengths-based, mental health consultation program, that helps support the social-emotional needs of children. ECCP staff work with teachers in the classroom over the course of six weeks to provide classroom-wide social, emotional or behavioral supports, overall classroom enhancement, and hands on strategies. Teachers welcomed the opportunity to work with a Master’s-level mental health professional to expand their knowledge and skills.

Pathways to Success



Brooker Memorial's Pathways to Success program offers aptitude testing and career counseling to high-school students. With generous funding by our Board of Managers, the Women and Girls Fund of the Northwest CT Community Foundation, and the City of Torrington Community Impact Grant, we helped 48 students last year identify their natural-born talents. Our goal is to provide the tools needed to set them up for a pathway of success as they leave high school.

Students from Torrington High School are selected to attend an intensive day-long series of aptitude tests at the Johnson O'Connor (JOC) Research Foundation in Boston. After completion, they attend a virtual session with their parents, and staff from JOC and Brooker to review their aptitudes and learn what career fields they may find both enjoyable and successful.

In May 2023, a Pathways Expo was offered at Torrington High School to introduce students to local professionals and potential mentors in various occupational fields that matched their testing results. Students had the opportunity to ask questions, gain insight into the day-to-day aspects of these careers, learn about the necessary education or training, and discover how they can prepare themselves for success.

Family Support

RELATIVES AS PARENTS PROGRAM (RAPP)

Brooker Memorial's Relatives as Parents Program is a support group for family members who are raising children who are not biologically their own. This program offers caregivers an opportunity to connect with others in similar situations, providing support, resources, and a sense of community. Whether it's navigating legal processes, finding educational resources, or simply sharing experiences, this program provides a safe space for those who find themselves in unique situations raising and supporting a child. Brooker is looking forward to expanding the program to meet the growing need in the community.

RUTH CHADWICK CARE CLOSET

Brooker has been supporting children and families in the community for over 100 years. Sometimes families find themselves needing a little help from time to time due to various reasons such as loss of employment, death in the family, illness, fire, and other causes. Brooke is fortunate to have the Ruth Chadwick Care Closet, in memory of Ruth Chadwick, a board member, incorporator, and volunteer of Brooker. Through the care closet, we are able to help families with monetary or material support. The funds from the care closet are used for both one-time needs and for providing Christmas gifts to families in our programs identified by Brooker staff.

Phase 2 Building Project

When Brooker Memorial renovated its existing building in 2015, 3,500 square feet of unfinished space was included on the second floor, anticipating that it would be completed when a community need for the space was identified. The growing demand for pediatric therapy provided onsite by our partner, Cheshire Fitness Zone, was just that need.

The second phase of the building project involved constructing an egress stairwell to meet fire code requirements and fully utilize the space. The completed area now boasts two gyms, a kitchen, six treatment rooms, clinical offices, and a waiting room to accommodate families seeking pediatric occupational, speech, physical, and feeding therapy. Additionally, the project included the installation of new ADA-accessible restrooms and expanded parking facilities.

We extend our sincere gratitude to our Board of Managers for their commitment to this project, and we appreciate the generous support from the State of Connecticut's Department of Economic and Community Development (DECD) for project financing.



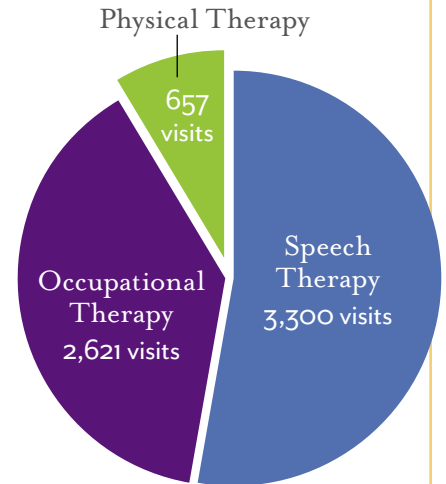
TORRINGTON PEDIATRIC THERAPY AT BROOKER — powered by Cheshire Fitness Zone

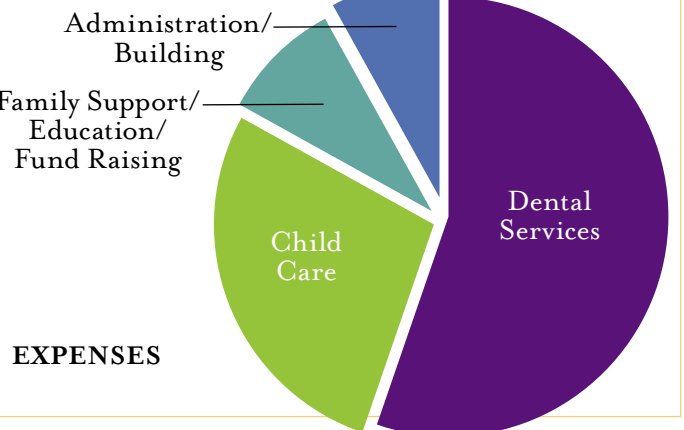

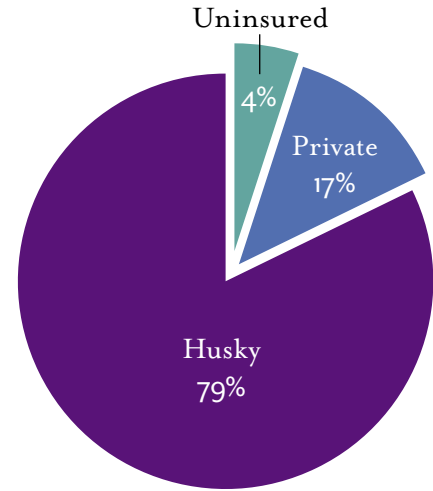

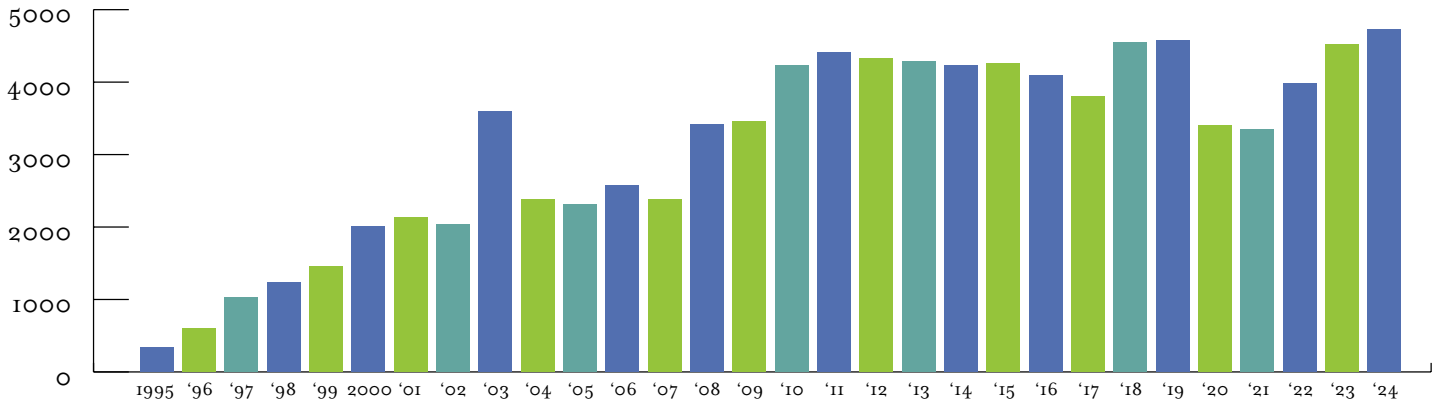

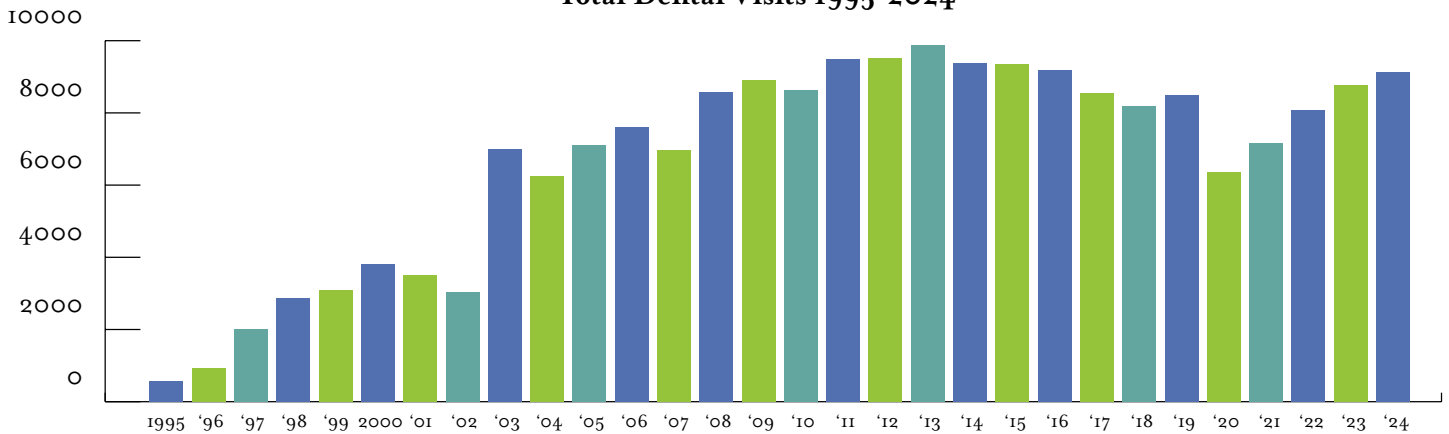
Patient Insurance Mix
