Brooker Memorial Pediatric Dental Center, in partnership with The Foundation for Community Health again will be offering Dental Cleanings, Oral Health Screenings, Fluoride and Sealants if necessary at your child's school. The program is open to all Pre-K to 8th grade students at no cost to your family.

The mobile dental program is inspected and licensed by the Connecticut Department of Public Health. A certified dental hygienist from Brooker Dental Center will provide services. A notice will be sent by mail informing you of treatment received, need for dental sealants and/or any recommendation to see your family dentist for areas of concern. If dental sealants are indicated, the hygienist will place them on another school day.

If your child has regular dental appointments with their family dentist or at Brooker Memorial, they are still eligible to participate in this program. The goal is to ensure that all children have access to dental care. We know how difficult it is to arrange work schedules to take your children for routine dental visits.

If you would like your child to receive preventive dental care through this program, simply fill out the information and consent on the forms included in this packet and return them to the school nurse. If insurance information is available and permission is given, we will submit a request to your dental insurance to help offset the cost of this program. Families will not be billed for any services received at the school.
